

Nebraska First Responder Recruitment & Retention Act

Law Enforcement Tuition Waiver Application and Certification of Verification

The Nebraska First Responder Recruitment and Retention Act provides a waiver of 100% of the resident tuition charges of law enforcement officers for a period of up to five years. A law enforcement officer, for the purposes of the program, is defined as any person who is responsible for the prevention of detection of crime of the enforcement of the penal, traffic or highway laws of the State of Nebraska or any political subdivision of the state for more than 100 hours per year and who is authorized by law to make arrests.

In order to establish eligibility for the waiver, an applicant must be enrolled to Metropolitan Community College and must complete and sign this application form. Additionally, the student's superior officer at the law enforcement agency at which the student is employed must sign this certificate attesting to the student's satisfactory performance as a law enforcement officer.
